June 2023

The company has made progress towards safely and permanently closing 29 ash ponds at 11 current and former coal-fired power plants across the state. Georgia Power remains committed to completely excavating 20 ash ponds and using proven engineering methods to close the remaining 9 ash ponds in place on our property.
