## LOCATION RESTRICTION DEMONSTRATION WETLANDS (40 C.F.R. PART 257.61) PLANT BOWEN ASH POND 1 (AP-1) GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

EPA's "Disposal of Coal Combustion Residuals from Electric Utilities Final Rule" (40 C.F.R. Part 257.61), requires that existing CCR surface impoundments must not be located in wetlands, as defined by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, without special considerations and permitting. AP-1 at Plant Bowen is utilized as a part of the Plant's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("NPDES") wastewater treatment system. A review of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service National Wetlands Inventory database (2018) identified no wetlands within the AP-1 boundary in this review. Therefore, Georgia Power's Plant Bowen AP-1 is not located in a wetland as defined by 40 C.F.R. Part 232.2.
