Plug-In Electric Vehicle Tariff

- By choosing to participate in the residential time-of-use Plug-In Electric Vehicle rate plan, you agree to pay the monthly Plug-In Electric Vehicle kWh usage amount for electric service to the designated account(s) and address for at least twelve months, beginning with the first bill rendered on the Plug-In Electric Vehicle rate.
- These Plug-In Electric Vehicle terms apply only for electric service to the designated account(s) and address. If you transfer service to another address, you will need to reapply for the Plug-In Electric Vehicle rate.
- Your Plug-In Electric Vehicle rate does not include fuel, taxes, and other charges, nor does it include Georgia Power security lights, or other Georgia Power products and services should you have any.
- Georgia Power can only offer the residential time-of-use Plug-In Electric Vehicle rate to customers who have had the AMI/smart meter installed on their residence. This meter replacement program is currently underway on a statewide basis.
- Georgia Power offers the Plug-In Electric Vehicle rate plan pursuant to the current residential rate filing, which is on file with the Georgia Public Service Commission.
