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18 CFR 5.18 REQUIREMENTS

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18 CFR § 5.18 (a) General Content Requirements. Each license application filed pursuant to this part must:

18 CFR § 5.18 (a)(1) Identify every person, citizen, association of citizens, domestic corporation, municipality, or state that has or intends to obtain and will maintain any proprietary right necessary to construct, operate, or maintain the project;

Georgia Power Company (GPC) is the only entity that has and will maintain any proprietary rights necessary to operate or maintain the project.

There is a total of approximately 14 acres (14.4 acres) of Federal land contained within the project boundary (land inside of the 868 PD elevation contour). The land is managed by the National Park Service (NPS) and is part of the Chattahoochee River National Recreation Area (CRNRA). The land occurs in the two CRNRA units. One is in the Vickery Creek unit and the other is in the Island Ford unit. The Vickery Creek unit contains approximately 3.7 acres while the Island Ford unit contains approximately 10.7 acres. There is no public land survey of these areas. Given that Georgia Power retained all rights sufficient to carry out project purposes on these federal lands, no annual charges should be assessed.


