- General Information:
1. Rip rap is recommended to eliminate erosion along the shoreline.
 2. The distance between the seawall and the shoreline should be held to an absolute minimum.
 3. The proposed seawall must be staked at 25' intervals in order for inspectors to insure the original contour is adhered to as close as possible. For very irregular shoreline, stakes shall be placed at 10' intervals.
 4. Wharves must be located as close as possible to the shoreline or seawall.
 5. Wharves may not extend more than six feet into the lake.
 6. Ramps should be constructed of reinforced concrete with a minimum thickness of four inches.
 7. Ramps may be up to 12' wide and a necessary length to access the lake.
 8. There is a ten foot setback from property lines for all structures.
