DESCRIPTION:

Green Energy is a rider that enables customers to support and foster the growth of renewable energy resources. Customers who choose to do so may purchase energy from renewable energy sources in 100 kWh energy blocks. The cost of each renewable energy block will be in addition to the customer's normal cost of electricity. Multiple blocks may be purchased. Energy purchased or produced from renewable energy sources may not be specifically delivered to the customer, but will displace incremental power that would have otherwise been produced from traditional generating sources. Green Energy purchases may include the use of Renewable Energy Credits. Customers may purchase certified green energy through four available options: Premium Green Energy, Standard Green Energy, the Large Volume Purchase Option, and the Special Event Purchase Option.

AVAILABILITY:

Throughout the Company's service area from existing lines of adequate capacity.

APPLICABILITY:

Applicable, upon request, to all residential, small nonresidential, medium nonresidential and large nonresidential customers in good financial standing with the Company. The Company will match up purchases to delivered energy on an ongoing basis.

MONTHLY RATE:

Premium Green Energy

\$5.00 per 100 kWh block

The Premium Green Energy offering will be supplied by energy produced from renewable resources that meet the requirements of the Green-e National Standard and are certified by the Center for Resource Solutions (CRS). At least 50% of the green energy purchased by Premium Green Energy customers will be provided from solar resources.

Standard Green Energy

\$3.50 per 100 kWh block

The Standard Green Energy offering will be supplied by energy produced from renewable resources that meet the requirements of the Green-e Energy National Standard and are certified by the Center for Resource Solutions (CRS).

MONTHLY MINIMUMS:

Residential **1 block**
Small Nonresidential **2 blocks**
Medium Nonresidential **25 blocks**
Large Nonresidential **400 blocks**

Residential – All customers on tariffs: R, TOU-REO, FLAT, TOU-PEV
Small Nonresidential – All customers on tariffs: FLAT, FS, GS, IOP, OGS, PLS, SASA, SASB, TOU-EO, UC
Medium Nonresidential – All customers on tariffs: APS, PLM, SCH, SLM, TOU-GSD, TOU-MB
Large Nonresidential – All customers on tariffs: ET, FPA, G, MLM, PLL, PLH, RTP, TOU-HLF, TOU-SC, TOU-SSD, TOU-RN

MINIMUM BLOCK EXCEPTION:

An exception to the minimum block requirement is granted to faith-based organizations and other non-profit groups that fall within the medium nonresidential rate class. Under this exception, faith-based and non-profit organizations in this class that meet the IRS Section 501(c)(3) and 501(a) requirements and have ten percent (10%) of the residential accounts within their membership or twenty-three (23) individual residential accounts, whichever is greater, subscribing to Green Energy (or its successor) will be allowed to purchase a minimum of two (2) blocks.

TERM OF CONTRACT:

Service under the GE rider shall be for a period of not less than one (1) year. Riders will automatically renew for additional one (1) year terms, unless the customer provides notice of cancellation at least sixty (60) days prior to the anniversary date of his contract. Subscribers are free to leave at any time after the first twelve (12) month term elapses after giving the Company sixty (60) days notice of intent to terminate or reduce subscription to purchase green energy. The Company reserves the right to terminate any or all contracts and/or riders at the Company's discretion.

State or Federal Legislation Opt-Out Clause: If State or Federal laws are instituted requiring Georgia Power to provide renewable resources, the Company maintains the right to cancel and void all contracts and sales through the Green Energy tariff without penalty.

LARGE VOLUME PURCHASE OPTION:

Customers who purchase at least 400 blocks (40,000 kWh) of Green Energy monthly, and who wish to purchase at least an additional 500 blocks (50,000 kWh) of renewable energy monthly, are eligible to purchase additional renewable energy under the Large Volume Purchase Option. The Company will contract with each interested customer individually to determine the price, quantity, term, and source of the additional green energy. Customers who act as a single brand under (1) common ownership or (2) under common control via a written franchise agreement with a single controlling entity may aggregate their load for the purposes of participating under the Large Volume Purchase Option.

SPECIAL EVENT PURCHASE OPTION:

Georgia Power may provide renewable energy for special events through one time purchases through the Special Event Purchase Option. A special event refers to a non-permanent assembly, e.g. a conference, concert, sporting event, etc., and shall not be used to procure renewable energy for permanent facilities.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

The charge calculated under this Rider is subject to change in such an amount as may be approved and/or amended by the Georgia Public Service Commission.
