AVAILABILITY:

Throughout the Company's service area from existing lines of adequate capacity in recognition of the economic conditions that adversely impact Industrial Customers.

APPLICABILITY:

Applicable to any Industrial Customer who was billed under the ILR-2 Rider as of December 31, 2007.

An Industrial Customer shall be defined as any customer using electric power as the principal motive power for the manufacture of a finished product, the extraction, fabrication or processing of a raw material, or the transportation or preservation of a raw material or a finished product.

In addition to the above applicability requirements, to be eligible for Part 2 of this rider, a customer must have received an Interruptible Service (IS) credit for September 2004 and must also have been under a continuous contract for the Demand Plus Energy Credit (DPEC) Rider since June 1, 2005.

APPLICATION OF INDUSTRIAL LOAD RETENTION:

Part 1

Accounts on this rider will receive a discount on their monthly base bill. For ILR customers who used more than 100,000,000 kWh in the calendar year 2006, the discount shall be equal to 0.0625¢ times all kWh usage. For ILR customers who used less than 100,000,000 in calendar year 2006, the discount shall be equal to 0.0261¢ per kWh times all kWh usage.

Part 2

Accounts qualifying for this part of the rider will receive the DPEC amount as specified in the DPEC rider. Additionally, in October of each year, the Company will calculate the amount that such customer would have been paid under the IS rider. The difference between the amount of DPEC actually paid and the amount of the calculated IS credit will be applied to such customer's bill.

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

The adjustment calculated under this rider is subject to change in such an amount as may be approved and/or amended by the Georgia Public Service Commission.
