AVAILABILITY:

Throughout the Company's service area from existing lines of adequate capacity.

APPLICABILITY:

Applicable to agricultural production including storage, drying, curing, handling, grain mill and oil mill operations and other agricultural related applications where at least Eighty percent (80%) of the annual kWh consumption occurs in any six (6) consecutive month period. The customer will be responsible to the Company for any additional cost of installing and removing any equipment required to control, meter or deliver this service. This electric service shall be delivered at one (1) point, at one (1) standard voltage and metered at or compensated to that voltage and is available to any customer with an actual demand of less than 500 kW.

TYPE OF SERVICE:

Single or three phase, 60 hertz, at a standard voltage.

MONTHLY RATE:

Energy Charge Including Demand Charge

Base Charge\$15.00

All consumption (kWh) not greater than 200 hours times the billing demand:

First 3,000 kWh	@	9.3527¢ per kWh
Next 2,000 kWh	@	8.5437¢ per kWh
Over 5,000 kWh.....	@	0.9491¢ per kWh

All consumption (kWh) in excess of 200 hours times the billing demand..... @0.9491¢ per kWh

Consumption during the on-peak period shall cause a surcharge of **14.1430** cents per kWh to be applied to kWh's which fall within the on-peak period.

Minimum Monthly Bill:

\$15.00 Base Charge plus kWh Charge plus Environmental Compliance Cost Recovery plus Fuel Cost Recovery, as applied to the current month kWh, plus Franchise Fee.

ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE COST RECOVERY:

The amount calculated at the above rate will be increased under the provisions of the Company's effective Environmental Compliance Cost Recovery Schedule, including any applicable adjustments.

FUEL COST RECOVERY:

The amount calculated at the above rate will be increased under the provisions of the Company's effective FCR Schedule, including any applicable adjustments.

FRANCHISE FEE:

The bill calculated under this tariff will be increased under the provisions of the Company's Franchise Fee Schedule, including any applicable adjustments.

ON-PEAK SERVICE:

The On-Peak period is defined as the hours starting at 2:00 p.m. and ending at 7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday for the billing months June through September (Summer Months). The above hours on days in which the following holidays are observed shall be considered Off-Peak: National Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day.

OFF-PEAK SERVICE:

The Off-Peak period is defined as all hours not included above including all weekends and the billing months of October through May (Winter Months).

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND:

The Billing Demand is the highest 30-minute kW measurement during the current month.

TERM OF CONTRACT:

Five (5) years.

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

The bill calculated under this tariff is subject to change in such an amount as may be approved and/or amended by the Georgia Public Service Commission under the provisions of applicable riders and other schedules.
