Dear Neighbor,

To support Georgia's growing energy needs and ensure we can continue to serve customers with reliability and resiliency for decades to come, Georgia Power is making necessary investments in our transmission system. As part of the company's investment plan, we are building multiple new transmission lines across the state, one of which is coming to this area.

The Ashley Park–Wansley 500kV project includes a 35-mile transmission line that will run between the Ashley Park substation — currently under construction in north Fayette County — and Plant Wansley in Heard County, crossing through Fulton and Coweta counties. This project will provide regional reliability, resiliency, and efficiency benefits.

We are currently in the early stages of surveying the area and are working to finalize the route. If the transmission line is expected to cross your property, you will be contacted directly by a Georgia Power representative regarding any potential impact to your property. We are also planning community meetings to share information and answer questions about the project. We will send a letter with those dates and times as they are confirmed.
