Audrey King is senior vice president (SVP) of Corporate Responsibility for Georgia Power and president & chief executive officer of The Georgia Power Foundation. In this role, King leads and directs the company's efforts to advance corporate responsibility, philanthropic and community engagement and volunteerism initiatives across the state, with a focus on education, the environment and empowering Georgia communities. She also is a member of the company's Management Council.

Prior to assuming this role in April 2025, King served as SVP of Region External Affairs for Georgia Power. In this role, she was responsible for leading the company's external activities across the state's 11 regions by providing leadership and support to region executives, engaging in strategic planning and workforce initiatives, while building and maintaining key stakeholder relationships.

Previously, she held the role of South Region vice president for Georgia Power, having direct responsibility for the company's external activities for customers across a 62-county area that includes Savannah, Valdosta and Albany. King has held various positions over more than 30 years in Customer Service, Sales, Distribution and External Affairs at the company. She began her career at Georgia Power as a customer service representative and has held other roles, including sales representative, auditor, support engineer, sales manager, external affairs manager, area manager and regional director.

In the community, King currently serves on the board of Atlanta Police Foundation, Atlanta Beltline Partnership and Savannah Economic Development Authority. She has also served on boards for the Savannah Area Chamber of Commerce, Union Mission, Inc., Savannah Technical College, Georgia Southern University Housing Foundation, Savannah Rotary Club and the advisory board for BankSouth. She was a member of United Way Executive Board, Homebuilders Association, Valdosta North Rotary Club Past-President and Honorary Commander for Moody Air Force Base. King also served on the State Housing Trust Fund for the Homeless and was Department of Community Affairs board chair.

King is a graduate of Leadership Lowndes, Leadership Savannah, and Leadership Georgia. She earned a Bachelor of Science in business administration from Troy University.
