## Business EV Charger Program

Georgia Power business customers may qualify for a \$500 rebate for each new 208/240-volt Level 2 workplace charger purchased and installed.

Eligibility requirements:

- ▶ Must be a Georgia Power business customer
- ▶ Each charger must have a dedicated circuit
- ▶ Third-party vendors or EV charging businesses not eligible
