## **AVAILABILITY:**

Throughout the Company's service area from existing lines of adequate capacity.

#### **APPLICABILITY:**

Applicable upon request as a modification of the tariff schedules for Power and Light, and Full Use Service to Governmental Institutions when off-peak usage exists.

#### **DEFINITIONS:**

- A. Off-peak usage is defined as power requirements occurring at all hours during the billing months October through May, all weekends, certain holidays, and between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. daily during the billing months June through September. The holidays to be observed are National Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day. The day on which the holiday is observed shall count as an off-peak day.
- B. On-peak usage is defined as all power requirements not included in (A) above.

#### **DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND:**

For rate schedules PLS, PLM, PLL and G, the billing demand as modified by this rider shall be the greater of:

- (1) Sixty percent (60%) of the highest current or preceding eleven (11) months off-peak demand, or,
- (2) The billing demand and determination based on the on-peak demand as specified in the applicable rate.

# **METERING:**

The customer may be responsible to the Company for any additional cost of installing and removing any equipment required to meter or deliver this service.

### **TERM OF CONTRACT:**

Not less than one year on the selected schedule.

# **GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:**

Service hereunder is subject to the Rules and Regulations for Electric Service on file with the Georgia Public Service Commission.
