Project Information

 - Establishing a new pathway based on sufficient need/demand (provides up to \$50,000)
 - Expansion or capacity building for existing pathway (provides up to \$50,000)
- Project Title:* This will be used in all correspondence and agreements to identify your proposal. The title should be descriptive of the location and action being taken. The one-sentence title should be around 10-15 words in length.
- Project Description:* In 350 words or less, provide a brief description of the project you would like to implement or expand (If you are a CTAE program, please utilize your school district's Perkins V Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment (CLNA)). In your summary, please include: a) An overview of the need; b) How you will use the WFGG grant to address the need; c) Overview of who will be served by the program; and d) A description of any partners/partner organizations and how they will support the project, if applicable.
- Community Need:*
 - New Pathway Grants only: In 300 words or less, please explain the local/regional labor market need for the new pathway. In your answer, include a) the data you used to determine the need for the new pathway; b) how you can ensure that, if awarded, you will have the capacity to implement the program effectively; and c) a sustainability plan after the grant period (if awarded). Please make sure you reference the [Locally Developed Pathway Course Process](#) before applying.
 - Expansion Grants only: In 300 words or less, please explain the need to expand the program. In your answer, include a) the data you used to determine the need for expanding the program; b) how the program was funded in the past; and c) a sustainability plan after the grant period (if awarded).
- Program Input:* In 250 words or less, provide a description of the program activities or inputs. In your answer, please include: a) How can you ensure that, if awarded, you can implement the project immediately? Include the proposed project start- date, key

intermediate milestones, and anticipated date of completion (please note that the grant period should be between 12-18 months, during which time you should be able to gather impact data to report to GPF/GFPE); b) Please describe the steps you will take during the grant period and how these steps will ensure your project is successfully implemented.

6. *Program Outputs:* In 250 words or less, provide a description of the program outputs. Specifically, provide information on the specific type (grade level(s), subject area(s), etc.) and number of students/teachers/administrators the project will serve.
7. *Program Goals:* Please provide: a) how will this grant produce measurable changes in the target population's lives. b) Identify at least 2 S.M.A.R.T. (specific, measurable, attainable, results-oriented, time-bound) goals that will show measurable impacts to the target population; and c) A description of how you will evaluate the project's effectiveness.
8. *Budget Narrative:* In 200 words or less, provide a description of how the grant funds will be used. In your summary, please include: a) Total costs for the project and a breakdown of how much will be for direct costs (equipment, technology, supplies, etc.) and indirect costs (operating, consultants, etc.) b) The projected or expected contributions of other funders (including in-kind donations of time and materials)
