Boatlifts and PWC Lifts





Boatlifts and PWC lifts are specifically intended for private, single family residential shoreline structures and may not be placed on multi-family, common, group use or commercial docks.

PWC lifts must be located inside the building envelope of the structure (i.e. behind dock, boathouse) and may not be separate from the dock/boathouse.

Boatlifts are only permissible if under an approved roofline of a boathouse.

Free standing boatlifts, in addition to and outside of an approved roofline of an existing or newly constructed boathouse are prohibited. (See Boathouse tab for more information)

Previously permitted, free standing boatlifts on Georgia Power Lakes may remain at the original location in which they were permitted. They cannot be moved to a different location on the lake.
