

Ash Pond Closures Update - July 2021

The company has made progress to safely and permanently close 29 ash ponds at 11 current and former coal-fired power plants across the state. Georgia Power remains committed to removing all coal ash from 19 ash ponds located adjacent to lakes or rivers and using proven engineering methods and technologies to close the remaining 10 ash ponds in place. As of July 2021, closure construction has progressed at 20 ash ponds at 9 facilities. The remaining 9 ponds are in various stages of engineering design, contracting, and/or early site preparation.
