

Glen Grizzle

Senior Vice President of Power Delivery • Georgia Power

Glen Grizzle serves as senior vice president of Power Delivery for Georgia Power. In this role, he is responsible for the planning, design, operations, construction and maintenance of Georgia Power's distribution and transmission systems. He also serves on the company's management council.

Grizzle began his career with Georgia Power in 1980 as a co-op student and joined the company full time in 1985 as an engineer in Thomson, Ga. Throughout his career, he has worked in multiple organizations and functions, including engineering, planning and management. His leadership positions with the company have included Cedartown area manager, West Region distribution manager in Columbus, substation design and construction manager and assistant to the vice president of transmission for Georgia Power.

Grizzle served as general manager of labor relations for Georgia Power, with responsibility for managing the company's relationship with IBEW Local 84. His responsibilities included negotiating contract changes, facilitating the grievance



process and administering the contract for business unit managers and the company's 3,000 covered employees. In 2011, he led the team that successfully negotiated a five-year contract, the longest in the history of Georgia Power's relationship with the union.

Prior to his current role, Grizzle served as vice president of corporate services for Georgia Power. In this role,

he provided leadership and oversight for safety and health, facilities management, fleet management and CSO resource management and compliance. Grizzle also served as a SCS vice president in a dual role with responsibility for Southern Company Gas fleet and facilities management.

Grizzle earned a bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering from Georgia Institute of Technology and completed the executive development program at Kellogg School of Management. He has held numerous charitable and community leadership positions statewide, including president of the Flint River Council of the Boy Scouts of America.
