

Ted McCullough

Senior Vice President and Senior Production Officer • Georgia Power

Ted McCullough is senior vice president and senior production officer for Georgia Power. In this position, he manages Georgia Power's approximately 13,314 megawatts of coal, natural gas, solar and hydro generating capacity.

Prior to this role, McCullough was executive vice president and chief production officer for Southern Company Generation after having served two years as executive vice president of Engineering & Construction Services.

McCullough joined Southern Company in 1987 and has held various engineering leadership positions with the company, including plant superintendent at Alabama Power's Lay



Dam, maintenance manager at Georgia Power's Plant Yates and plant manager at Southern Power's Plant Franklin and Georgia Power's Plant Branch. He has also served as vice president and senior production officer for both Gulf Power and Alabama Power.

McCullough serves on the board of the Association of Edison Illuminating Companies (AEIC) and is a member of its Generation Committee.

He is a registered professional engineer with degrees in electrical engineering and mathematics from Vanderbilt University. He also has a master's degree in business administration from Auburn University.
