Evans is currently on the board of Southwest Gas Holdings, a natural gas distribution and construction company, serving Nevada, Arizona, and California. He also uses his time in service to the community. Evans serves on the Grady Health Foundation, and previously served as the Audit Chair of the Grady Memorial Hospital Corporation. Additionally, he is a member of the Emory Board of Trustees and the executive committee of Zoo Atlanta.
