

Toshiba-Vogtle Nuclear
Expansion Credits

Customer credits due to payments from Toshiba for the Vogtle nuclear expansion. Credits will appear on 2018 bills as the *Vogtle Settlement Refund*.

All customers will receive the same credit regardless of usage.

$$\begin{matrix} \$25 \\ \text{April} \end{matrix} + \begin{matrix} \$25 \\ \text{July} \end{matrix} + \begin{matrix} \$25 \\ \text{Sept.} \end{matrix} = \$75$$

Tax Cuts and
Jobs Act Refunds

The typical residential customer* could receive three separate refunds over the next two years.

$$\begin{matrix} \$27 \\ \text{Oct.} \\ 2018 \end{matrix} + \begin{matrix} \$20 \\ \text{June} \\ 2019 \end{matrix} + \begin{matrix} \$22 \\ \text{Feb} \\ 2020 \end{matrix} = \$69$$

Nuclear Construction
Cost Recovery Savings

The typical residential customer can expect to pay approximately \$9 less in financing costs for the Vogtle nuclear expansion in 2018 than 2017.

As a regulated utility, Georgia Power is allowed the opportunity to earn a return on equity within a set range each year. In March 2018, Georgia Power issued \$43.6 million in refunds for customers due to the company's higher earnings in 2016.*
