In a letter dated June 25, 2020, the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) conditionally approved a Voluntary Remediation Program (VRP) Compliance Status Report (CSR) for the above-referenced site. EPD has since reviewed the Uniform Environmental Covenants (UECs) for the associated properties, recorded on May 7, 2021. Based on the CSR approval and the recorded UECs, EPD has determined that the CSR is complete and meets the requirements of the Georgia VRP Act. EPD concurs with your certification of compliance that the site is in compliance with non-residential risk reduction standards (RRS) for soil and Type 5 RRS for groundwater, for regulated substances associated with releases from this site. Therefore, I am reclassifying this site as a Class III site, and I am removing it from the Hazardous Site Inventory in accordance with Subparagraph 391-3-19-.05(4)(b) of the Rules for Hazardous Site Response (Rules) and §12-8-107(f) of the VRP Act as of the date of this letter. As required by Subparagraph 391-3-19-.06(5)(f) of the Rules, a public notice announcing this determination shall be published in the *Savannah Morning News*.

Please adhere to the terms of the UECs, which document institutional controls being relied upon to maintain compliance. Note that a portion of tax parcel 1-0727-01-003 has been impacted by a release at Atlantic Wood Industries, HSI 10018, and therefore remains a part of that 'Site" as defined in Subparagraph 391-3-19-.02(2)(v) of the Rules.
