On behalf of Georgia Power, Southern Company is filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) an application for a new license for the Wallace Dam Project in compliance with the Commission's Integrated Licensing Process regulations at 18 C.F.R. Part 5. The current Wallace Dam Project license expires May 31, 2020.

A description of the license application components along with volume locations is provided below. In accordance with FERC regulations found at 18 C.F.R. § 388.112, we request that documents that contain Critical Energy Infrastructure Information (CEII) as noted below be withheld from public disclosure. 
