



EV Charger Rebate

2026 Terms & Conditions for the Georgia Power Company Residential Electric Vehicle Charger Rebate Program

1. **The Rebate Program.** Georgia Power is offering this Residential Electric Vehicle Charger Rebate Program (“**Rebate Program**”) to help residential customers offset the cost of purchasing and installing electric vehicle chargers. Georgia Power customers who install a Level 2 (208/240v) EVSE charger (“**EVSE Charger**”) may qualify for a rebate for each charger installed (up to 2 EVSE Chargers per account). Due to limited funding, rebates are offered for installations completed on or before **December 31, 2026**, subject to funding availability.

Please Note: Rebate submissions must be completed online through the Georgia Power EV Rebate Portal within 6 months of the vehicle charger installation date.

2. **Required Documentation.** As part of the submission process, you must provide the following documentation:
 - 2.1. A copy of the installation invoice clearly identifying the installer, the installation address, and the date of the installation completion date; and
 - 2.2. A copy of the charger invoice clearly showing where the charger was purchased. If a charger was provided with the purchase of the vehicle, it must be individually invoiced or priced as a line item on the dealer invoice/bill of sale
 - 2.3. Georgia Power reserves the right to require additional documentation and to cancel or modify Rebate Program at any time in its sole and absolute discretion.

3. **Charger Eligibility Requirements and Restrictions.**

- 3.1. Must be a Level 2 (208/240 volt) Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment (“EVSE”) charger.
- 3.2. Must be a wall or pedestal-mounted charger. Mobile chargers or connectors of any kind, including, but not limited to, the Tesla Charger Gen 2 Mobile Connector, are **NOT** eligible for the Georgia Power EV Charger Rebate.
- 3.3. Must have a dedicated (208/240 volt) circuit. The charger must not share a circuit or outlet with any other piece of equipment.
- 3.4. Must be new (not used, refurbished, rented, etc.) and purchased by the customer.
 - 3.4.1. EVSE Chargers that were gifted or won by the customer are not eligible for rebates.
 - 3.4.2. EVSE Chargers purchased from other utilities’ marketplaces/online stores are not eligible for rebates.
 - 3.4.3. If your charger is self-installed, you may still be eligible for a rebate. You must provide a photo of the installed charger that shows the installation, and a signed and dated document attesting to self-installation.
- 3.5. A rebate will be provided for each charger installed, subject to funding availability.
- 3.6. The rebate is limited to the customer’s actual, documented charger purchase and installation costs.
- 3.7. EVSE Chargers may be of any manufacturer, make, or model provided they meet the requirements herein.
- 3.8. Customer must comply with all applicable city, county, or state government, property owner, or homeowner’s association rules, codes, and regulations during installation of the EVSE Charger. Customer must obtain and maintain all necessary permits prior to and during installation. Level 2 charging occurs at a higher voltage rate than the Level 1 (120 volt) charger, and installation may require an inspection and permit from the applicable city or county authority. Customers are encouraged to consult with a qualified electrician to determine the permitting and inspection requirements for the EVSE Charger, and are not required to use a participating EVSE Charger Installer to be eligible for the Residential Electric Vehicle Charger Rebate.

4. Customer Eligibility Restrictions.

- 4.1. Must be a Georgia Power customer.
- 4.2. EVSE Chargers purchased on Georgia Power Marketplace that received the **\$150 instant rebate** are not eligible.
- 4.3. Eligible customers must be the property owner or have the express written permission of the property owner to install the EVSE Charger.
- 4.4. Rebate Program is open to all single-family residential customers regardless of electric service rate.
- 4.5. Residential customers do not have to be on the Plug-In Electric Vehicle (PEV) Rate in order to be eligible for the rebate.
- 4.6. Residential customers can receive a maximum of two (2) Residential EVSE Charger Rebates per account for the life of the account.

5. **Inspection and Verification.** All EVSE Chargers installed under this Rebate Program are subject to visual verification by the Georgia Power Corporate Compliance Organization (“GPCCO”). If your EVSE Charger installation is selected for a field audit, you will be contacted by a GPCCO representative to schedule an appointment. By signing and submitting the Rebate Request Form, the customer agrees to provide a GPCCO representative reasonable access to the installation site during normal business hours. If the field audit discovers that the EVSE Charger has not been installed, the rebate will not be paid, or if the rebate has already been issued, the customer will be responsible for repayment of the rebate to Georgia Power.

6. **Voluntary Data Collection.** Customers participating in the Electric Vehicle Charger Rebate Program consent to Georgia Power’s collection of data related to the installation and use of the EVSE Charger in order to better understand EV charging practices, improve EV services, and support greater EV deployment. Such data may include, for example, the number of EVSE Chargers installed and the frequency of their use by EV drivers. Customers may opt out of this data collection at any time by notifying Georgia Power, and opting out will not affect rebate eligibility. 7. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY; NO REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES.

- 7.1. **GEORGIA POWER’S SOLE LIABILITY AND RESPONSIBILITY IN CONNECTION WITH THE THIS ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGER REBATE PROGRAM, INCLUDING GPCCO FIELD AUDITS, WILL BE STRICTLY LIMITED TO THE PAYMENT OF AN APPLICABLE REBATE AMOUNT FOR ELIGIBLE EQUIPMENT AS EXPRESSLY PROVIDED UNDER THE REBATE PROGRAM. THE REBATE PAYMENT SHALL CONSTITUTE THE CUSTOMER’S SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE REMEDY AGAINST GEORGIA POWER ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING TO THE REBATE PROGRAM.**
- 7.2. **GEORGIA POWER MAKES NO, AND HEREBY EXPRESSLY DISCLAIMS ALL REPRESENTATIONS, WARRANTIES, COVENANTS OR GUARANTIES OF ANY KIND, WHETHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, IN CONNECTION WITH ANY ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGER, ITS INSTALLATION, ITS PERFORMANCE, OR THE REBATE PROGRAM, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, ANY IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, NON-INFRINGEMENT, OR ARISING FROM COURSE OF DEALING OR USAGE OF TRADE. ALL WARRANTIES, IF ANY, WITH RESPECT TO THE ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGER ARE PROVIDED SOLELY BY THE MANUFACTURER, AND CUSTOMER WILL LOOK EXCLUSIVELY TO THE MANUFACTURER FOR ANY SUCH WARRANTY CLAIMS.**
- 7.3. **TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW, GEORGIA POWER WILL NOT BE LIABLE FOR ANY CLAIMS OR DAMAGES OF ANY KIND ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING TO THIS REBATE PROGRAM OR ANY EVSE CHARGERS, WHETHER IN CONTRACT, TORT, STRICT LIABILITY, OR OTHERWISE, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, ANY INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, SPECIAL EXEMPLARY, OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES, LOSS OF USE, LOSS OF DATA, LOST PROFITS, OR BUSINESS INTERRUPTION, EVEN IF GEORGIA POWER HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES.**
- 7.4. **CUSTOMER ACKNOWLEDGES AND AGREES THAT GEORGIA POWER DOES NOT INSTALL, INSPECT, SUPERVISE, CONTROL, OR WARRANTY THE WORK OF ANY MANUFACTURER, ELECTRICIAN, TECHNICIAN, CONTRACTOR, OR OTHER THIRD PARTY, AND THAT ANY FIELD AUDIT OR SITE VISIT IS PERFORMED SOLELY FOR THE REBATE PROGRAM ADMINISTRATIVE PURPOSES AND WILL NOT BE CONSTRUED AS AN APPROVAL, CERTIFICATION, OR VERIFICATION OF CODE COMPLIANCE OR SAFETY.**
- 7.5. **COMPLIANCE WITH ALL APPLICABLE FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL LAWS, CODES, ORDINANCES, PERMITTING, INSPECTION, AND REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS ARE SOLELY THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMER. GEORGIA POWER WILL HAVE NO LIABILITY OR RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY ACT OR OMISSION OF ANY THIRD PARTY, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, ANY EQUIPMENT INSTALLED BY, OR FOR ANY ACT OR**

OMISSION OF, ANY OTHER ENTITY OR INDIVIDUAL, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, EQUIPMENT MANUFACTURER, ANY ELECTRICIAN, TECHNICIAN, OR OTHER SERVICE PROVIDER.

8. **Rebate Submissions.** Submit your Residential Electric Vehicle Charger Rebate request at georgiapower.com/evrebate along with an installation and a charger invoice. Submission of a request does not guarantee approval. Funding is subject to availability and compliance with applicable terms and conditions.
9. **Other Related EV Rebates.** Builder Incentive for EVSE Chargers installed in New Homes: In addition to other new-home rebate incentives, a \$100 rebate is available to builders who install EVSE Chargers in new homes.
