You don't have to choose between comfort and saving energy. Through the Energy Assistance for Savings & Efficiency (EASE) program, income-eligible Georgia Power customers can apply for **free**, **energy-efficiency home improvements**. From improved attic insulation to smart thermostats that can help manage your home's temperature, energy efficiency improvements can help you save energy and money.

Program Eligibility

- · You must be a Georgia Power residential customer.
- · Your household income meets the requirements.1

Your total household income must be equal to or below the numbers in the chart in order to qualify for program participation.

Household Size	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8
Annual Income	\$30,120	\$40,880	\$51,640	\$62,400	\$73,160	\$83,920	\$94,680	\$105,440
Monthly Income	\$2,510	\$3,407	\$4,303	\$5,200	\$6,097	\$6,993	\$7,890	\$8,787

Add \$10,760 for each additional person per year to the annual income of \$105,440 to calculate the annual income maximum for household sizes over 8.

Step 3: If approved for the program, a Georgia


Power Energy Efficiency Assessor will

qualified energy-efficiency improvements


