

Georgia Power donates \$150,000 to Safe Kids Savannah

"Safety is Georgia Power's top priority," said Cathy Hill, vice president of Georgia Power's Coastal Region. "And we're very excited that we'll be able to support Memorial as they go to schools and communities throughout the coastal Georgia area in helping to keep our kids safe. It's all about educating children and their families on how they can be safe."

"Accidental injuries kill more children each year than all diseases combined, so having this \$150,000 will go a long way towards education to prevention of some of those injuries," said Bill Lee, senior vice president of Memorial Health.

"We provide car seats, safety checks so for families that are discharged that can't provide or a car seat, we provide a car seat for them," Lee said. "For other activities, with helmets, bicycle helmets, we provide helmets for children who are not able to have those."
